

REGIONAL AIRPORT TERMINAL BUILDING DUBUQUE, IOWA



The new terminal building will be built over the next year to replace the existing antiquated facility built in the 1950's, 60's and 80's. The structure features horizontal and tilted cantilevered roof surfaces separated by clerestories and connected by stone monolith walls. The initial construction will accommodate three airlines, three rental car companies, and three arrival/departure gates, with the ability to expand on three sides to accommodate future growth at the airport and the surrounding community. The intent is to improve flight services to the region and foster competition with nearby airport facilities in Cedar Rapids, Rockford, Madison, and the Quad Cities.
