

FOUNDATION INSPECTION FOR MANUFACTURED HOUSING ILLINOIS, IOWA, AND WISCONSIN

Manufactured housing financed through the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) needs documentation confirming that a support system (foundation and hold-downs) was installed conforming to the Permanent Foundations Guide for Manufactured Housing (September 1996). Normally, a letter from a structural engineer is sufficient to satisfy HUD requirements. The actual scope of work typically includes a site visit to observe the as-built condition, review of the Guide, identification of elements not conforming to HUD standards, and a letter summarizing our findings and professional opinions.
